

Making Lapel PINS

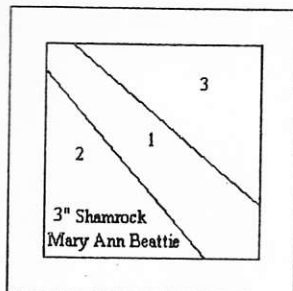
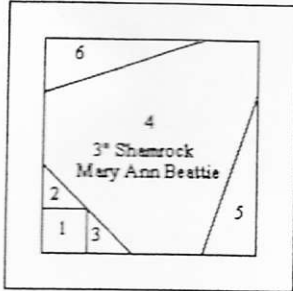
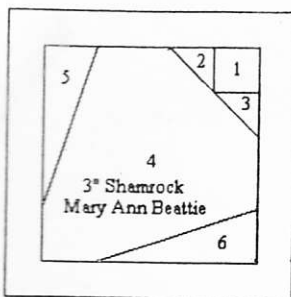
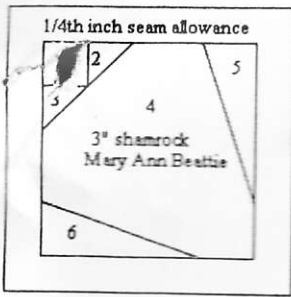
Scraps of fabric
paper-piecing pattern for a 2 - 3" finished block
batting remenant
backing fabric
1" pin clasp (from a local craft store)

Simply make your favorite 2" - 3" paper-piecing design with your fabric scraps. This can be a "theme" pin for Breast Cancer or a patriotic cause or a favorite miniature quilt block.

Sandwich your tiny block with the top, batting, and backing. At this juncture, it is important to decide if you will bind the tiny piece or if you will sew around it and simply turn it inside out. Either way, finish just like a larger quilt.

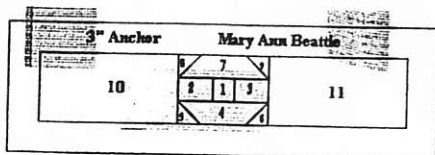
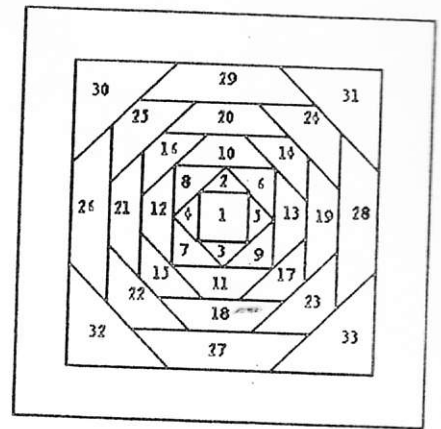
Quilt and embellish to your heart's content.

Hand stitch the little 1" pin clasp to the back of your pin and begin wearing it with pride!or gift it with love to a friend.

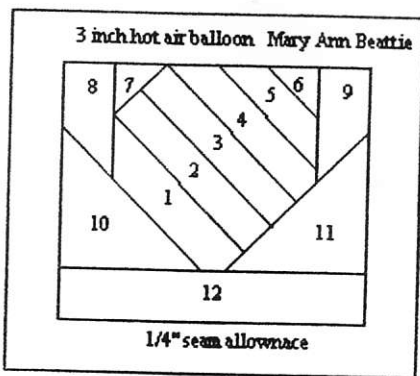
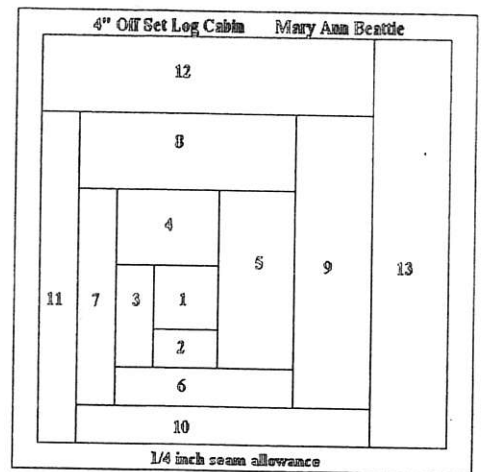
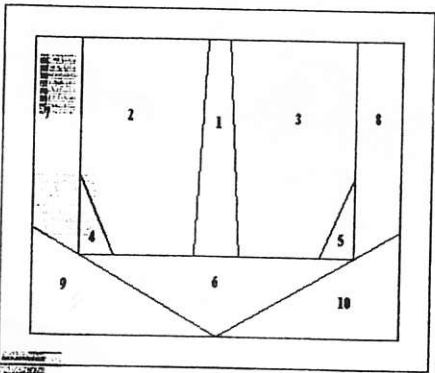


Shamrock

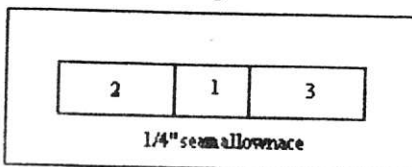
Pineapple



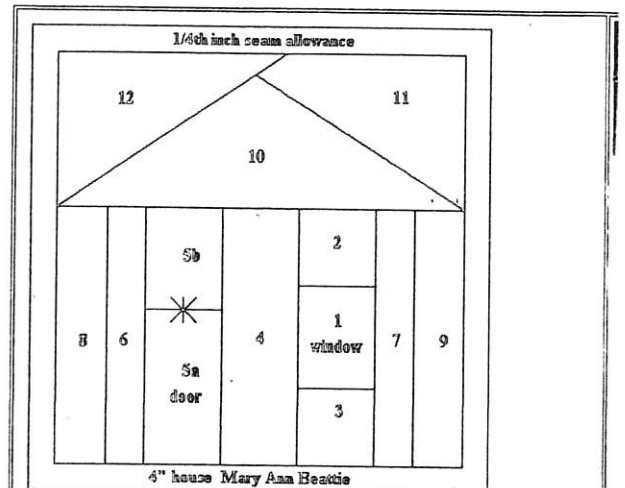
Sew together here
